# St. Thomas, US Virgin Islands

Please note that most of the transportation used in St. Thomas are open-air safari type vehicles

### **Sightseeing Tours**

Coral World Ocean Park

STTX0111

Approx. 3 1/4 hrs.

Level 2. Family

Descend below the sea in the Observation Tower built right into the ocean.

- Step into the center of an 80,000 gallon living coral reef in the Caribbean Reef Encounter.
- Touch a sea star, feed stingrays and colorful Lorikeets, and get close to endangered sea turtles.
- Follow the board walk to the beach to swim or just soak up the sun.

A souvenir map will be provided for your self-guided tour.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Children 3 years of age or younger are free if accompanied by a participating paying adult.

The Best of St. Thomas

STTX0711

Approx. 3 hrs.

Level 1, Family

- Board your open-air safari bus and travel along the scenic east coast of St. Thomas where you'll take in the views of the neighboring islands.
- Then it's on to Beacon Point, which offers breathtaking island views from the observation platform.
- Stop at Skyline Drive for an overlook view of Charlotte Amalie, 800 feet above sea level.
- Visit Mountain Top and view Magen's Bay from Drake's Seat before continuing to St. Peter Great House and botanical gardens.

Enjoy a complimentary rum or fruit punch.

Note: Guests ending the tour in Charlotte Amalie are responsible for their taxi fare back to the ship. Tours departing in the afternoon do not have the option of remaining in Charlotte Amalie for shopping. There are steps at St. Peter Great House and the botanical nature trail has two flights of stairs down and back up.

Downtown Shopping & Magen's Bay Beach

STTX1311

Approx. 5 1/2 hrs.

Level 1, Family

- Board an open air safari bus for a scenic ride to world famous Magen's Bay.
- Enjoy approximately 2 hours of swimming, sunbathing and relaxing.
- Meet your driver for the transfer to downtown Charlotte Amalie for approximately 2 hours of shopping time, after which return to the ship.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. A credit card may be required for rentals and food purchase. Restrooms are available at both the beach and downtown.

Skyride to Paradise Point

STTX1711

**Duration: Varies** 

Level 1, Family

- View the harbor, cruise ships and hillside town of Charlotte Amalie from 800 feet above sea level.
- The round trip Skyride is approx. 15 minutes, allowing plenty of time at the top to relax with a drink or lunch at additional cost.
- Come at your leisure as the Skyride runs continuously.

Note: Transportation to and from the Skyride is at your own leisure and expense. There are 25 steps at the Skyride entrance and 10 at the top, including the optional Nature Trail. Children 5 years of age and under are free.

Accessible St. Thomas Island Drive

STTX6311

Approx. 2 1/2 hrs.

Level 1, Weight, Guests with disabilities

- Tour St. Thomas in a custom vehicle fully equipped for limited mobility and wheelchair access.
- View the airport and college as your guide shares some history, landmarks and legends and travel up to Mountain Top for a photo stop.
- Stop at Drake's Seat overlooking Magen's Bay and Mahogany Run Golf Course before heading to Beacon Point.

Note: Maximum lift weight is 600 lbs. When booking this tour you must inform the Shore Excursion team if you are an able-bodied passenger or if you use a collapsible wheelchair or a scooter.

Discover St. Thomas & Magen's Bay

STTX6911

Approx. 5 hrs.

Level 2, Family

- Begin with a scenic ride along Skyline Drive offering breathtaking views of Charlotte Amalie Harbour, the Caribbean Sea, the British Virgin Islands and Magen's Bay one of the top ten beaches in the world.
- Enjoy a photo stop before continuing down to Magen's Bay for two hours of sun, swimming and fun.
- Continue on to Blackbeard's Castle and the surrounding Kongens (King's) Quarter, the former center of Danish colonial enterprise.
- Visit the Antique Print Gallery, as well as admire the spectacular Caribbean World Amber Waterfall, cascading two stories down and comprised of over 12,000 stones of amber.
- At the completion of your visit it's just steps to Main Street to indulge your passion for the great recommended shopping in St. Thomas.
   Note: Tour Participants are responsible for return transportation from the downtown shopping district. Taxis are readily available.

Coral World & Butterfly Garden

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs.

Drive to Coral World Ocean Park where you will receive a brief orientation and a souvenir map for your 90 min self-guided tour.

- Pet a shark, touch a sea star, feed stingrays and colorful Lorikeets, get close to endangered sea turtles.
- Depart for the Butterfly Garden, a tropical oasis where butterflies from around the world fly free and your guide will entertain you with commentary on their amazing lifestyles.
- Continue to explore on your own, enjoy gift shops at both venues and at Coral World you can relax and refresh at one of the open air cafes.

Panoramic Views of St. Thomas & Shopping STTX7911

Approx. 2 ½ hrs.

Level 2

Drive along Skyline Drive with the Charlotte Amalie Harbor and the Caribbean Sea on your left and the Atlantic Ocean with splendid views of Magen's Bay on your right.

Browse the aisles as bargains abound for every budget. While traveling down the winding mountain roads, and enjoying the views, your next stop will be Paradise Point Tramway. Your excursion includes your round-trip tram ride and a complimentary bushwacker cocktail.

Once at the top, there are many shops, a bird show and tasty treats and beverages for purchase. Be sure to bring you camera to capture the amazing views you'll see on this tour. At your leisure, ride the tram to the bottom and walk through the Havensight Mall, full of shops on your way back to your ship.

**Adventure & Water Based Tours** 

Screamin' Eagle Jet Boat

STTX0511

Approx. 11/4 hrs.

Level 2, Height

• This 700 HP turbo-charged jet boat will take you on a high speed harbor and coastline tour.

Experience fun, sea spray and exhilarating speed along with 180 degree spins. Total time on the water is 30-35 minutes.

Note: Not recommended for pregnant women or guests with back or neck problems. Min. height is 4ft tall. Wear swimsuit and bring a towel.

Sea Trekkin' Helmet Dive

STTX1211

Approx. 3 ½ hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight

Take a scenic drive to Coral World Ocean Park, once there suit up in your water shoes, gloves and sea trek dive helmet.

• Your guide will lead groups of up to 10 along a trail 15 to 18 feet below the surface.

• With a railing for stability, trek among coral reefs as the marine life comes right up to your helmet.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Min. age 8yrs, min. weight 80lbs. Must be able to climb a ladder in and out of the water. Not recommended for guests with physical disabilities or claustrophobia. Water shoes, gloves and a storage box for your belongings are provided.

Magen's Bay Beach Getaway

STTX1411

Approx. 3 hrs.

Level 1, Family

Take a scenic drive to Drake's Seat with views of the nearby British Virgin Islands.

• Enjoy approximately 2 hours on the beach.

• Snack bar (at an extra charge), restrooms and shower facilities are available.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Beach chairs and floats are available for rent at an additional charge.

Kayak, Hike & Snorkel at Cas Cay

STTX2011

Approx. 4 hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight

Experience the St. Thomas Mangrove Wildlife Refuge and Marine Sanctuary, while your guide will explain the eco system.

• Hike through a mangrove forest, along a scenic beach of coral & shell rubble.

• Snorkel in the clear waters of the coral fringed mangrove nursery and over the remnants of a shipwreck.

Note: Min. age is 6 and max. age is 80yrs. Max. weight 300lbs. Must be able to get in and out of kayaks unassisted. Guests with heart or lung conditions, back, neck or wrist injuries should not participate. Snorkel gear, snack and beverage are included. Wear swimsuit and bring a towel.

Powercat Snorkel & Beach

STTX2411

Approx. 4 hrs.

Level 2, Weight

Full snorkel equipment and friendly instructions will be provided for beginners and experienced snorkelers.

Swim and snorkel with green sea turtles, abundant tropical fish and colorful coral formations at Buck Island.

• After an hour snorkeling, board Breeze for another power cruise to Honeymoon Beach, where you can relax, swim, sunbathe or join the Breeze crew in beach volleyball.

On your return pass the historical Hassel Island and bustling St. Thomas waterfront (downtown drop-off available for AM guests).

Note: Max. weight 300lbs. Guests with cardiac conditions, asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, other heart or respiratory conditions or any other medical condition should take particular caution. Hot food is available for purchase on the beach. The boat has 1 level main-deck, cushioned seats, 2 toilets & 75% shaded area.

Snuba at Coral World

STTX2511

Approx. 31/2 hrs.

Level 2. Age

Drive to Coral World Ocean Park where you'll be escorted to the Snuba orientation area and receive a briefing on how to use the equipment and what you can expect on your dive.

After your Snuba experience, explore Coral World, where you'll be able to watch behaviors hard to see in the wild.

Shop at one of the unique gift shops and enjoy a snack or a specialty frozen Shark Bite drink at the Shark Bar

Note: Min. age 8yrs and max. weight 350lbs. Guests with recent surgeries, high blood pressure, epilepsy, seizures and asthma are not allowed to participant except with a doctor's authorization letter. Medical waiver required to be completed by every participant.

Discover Scuba & Snorkel Tour

STTX3411

Approx. 4hrs.

Level 2, Age, Family

Experience the wonders of breathing underwater without Scuba certification.

Your dive instructor will give you an instructional session covering the basics of Scuba Diving.

You'll also have some free time for snorkeling or just relaxing on the boat.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Min. age is 10. Must be able to swim. Medical waiver required; please see the Shore Excursion Staff onboard. Dive time depends on air consumption. Approximate time spent in the water is a total of 45 minutes.

St. Thomas Parasailing

STTX3711

Approx. 1 1/4 hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight

Enjoy an exhilarating parasail ride as you get a bird's eye view of St. Thomas and its neighboring islands.

Note: Minimum age is 6. Minimum weight 90 lbs. and max 450lbs. combined. This tour is subject to strict safety regulations, thus may cancel should the tour operator determine is necessary.

Turtle Cove Power Snorkel

STTX4311

Approx. 3 ½ hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight

Board a custom-built sailing catamaran for a 60 minute sail to Turtle Cove on Buck Island, a remote island off the St. Thomas coast.

View tropical fish, colorful coral covered boulders and green sea turtles gliding along in their natural habitat grazing on sea grasses.

• If you prefer to stay onboard, enjoy sunbathing decks and a large comfortable canopied cockpit for those who prefer the shade.

Enjoy Caribbean music, beverages and light snacks on the cruise back to the dock. Also included are personal "pirate" tattoos, and complimentary website photos to cherish for years to come.

Note: Participants must be at least 14 years of age and free of heart conditions and asthma. Maximum weight 275 lbs. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. Actual snorkel time is 1 1/2 hours (30 minutes with the power snorkel, 60 minutes without).

Castaway Shipwreck Sail & Snorkel

STTX4611

Approx. 3 hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight, Family

- The Castaway Girl is fast and stable, having spacious sunbathing decks and a large comfortable cockpit for those of you preferring the shade.
- Spend 1½ hours at Shipwreck Cove snorkelling and exploring beautiful coral reefs filled with tropical fish.
- The wartime shipwreck of the "Catanza C" lies 25' below the surface and is home to a wide variety of sea life.
- Enjoy complimentary tropical fruit punch drinks, the Castaway Girl Painkiller Punch and snacks on your way back.

Note: Participants must be a minimum of 6 years of age and weigh no more than 300 lbs. Guests must be able to get in and out of the water and up the easy boarding ladder unaided. All snorkelers must wear safety snorkel vests, which are provided. Wear swimsuit and bring towel. Min. age is 6. All snorkelers must wear life vest provided.

Sea Lion Swim & Coral World Ocean Park

STTX5911 Approx. 4 hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight

- Arriving at Coral World Ocean Park, you will be escorted to the undersea observatory tower to meet your sea lion trainer, who will introduce you to sea lions in their salt water habitat.
- You will touch and play games with the sea lions as they demonstrate their remarkable agility, you'll practice the hand signals used by the trainers, and at the end of the encounter your playful hosts give a hug, a kiss and pose for photos.
- After the interaction, tour the park and see the beauty of Caribbean marine life.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Min. weight is 50lbs. Min. age is 8yrs. Must be physically fit enough to climb in and out of the sea lion pool via a ladder. No observers are allowed in sea lion swim area. Must be comfortable in 8ft of water, wearing a life vest. Children under 12 must have a participating adult with them. Personal cameras aren't permitted during the sea lion swim. Coral World photographers take photos in and out of the water. CD with your photos is available for purchase.

### **B.O.S.S. Underwater Adventure**

STTX6011

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs.

Level 2, Age, Height, Weight

- B.O.S.S. (Breathing Observation Submersible Scooter) Underwater Adventure allows you to view the marvels of the sea.
- Board a 60 foot custom dive boat to cruise to your dive site, then drive your own B.O.S.S. unit on a guided tour of the reef.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Min. age is 10yrs; min. height is 4ft tall. Max. weight 350lbs. Must be able to enter and exit water using a swim ladder and platform. Must be in good physical condition and sign a waiver. Not recommended for guests with physical disabilities or claustrophobia. Medical waiver required; please see the Shore Excursion Staff onboard. Small snack and refreshment provided.

### Certified SCUBA Two Tank Dive

STTX6111

Approx. 4 hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight, Card Required

- Visit the dive shop to complete the pre-dive formalities and then board your motorized catamaran for a ride to the dive site.
- Sites are chosen daily to ensure best possible conditions.
- A maximum depth of 60 feet is usually reached on the first dive. Second dive is in shallow water.

**Note:** Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Min. age is 10. Must present Diver Certification Card and log book. Dive sites subject to change. Must have logged a minimum of 1 dive within the last 12 months. Medical waiver required; please see the Shore Excursion Staff onboard. Boat trip to dive site may be choppy.

### Turtle Cove Catamaran Sail & Snorkel

STTX6711

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs.

Level 2, Weight, Family

- Board a custom-built sailing catamaran for a 60 minute sail to Turtle Cove on Buck Island, a remote island off the St. Thomas coast.
- Once anchored your crew will provide instructions and lead a guided snorkeling tour. Stay at Turtle Cove will be approx. 90 min.
- Enjoy Caribbean music, beverages and light snacks on the cruise back to the dock. Also included are personal "pirate" tattoos, and complimentary website photos to cherish for years to come.

**Note:** Participants must be at least 8 years of age to snorkel. Maximum weight allowed is 275 lbs. A ladder with 5 to 8 steps is used to enter and exit the water from the sailboat. Snorkeling lesson and equipment, including snorkel vest are included. An alternate snorkeling site may be used if weather conditions are not favorable.

### Jeep® Safari & Beach

STTX6811

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs.

Level 2, Age

- Your experienced guide will lead the Convoy while indicating points of interest over a hand held radio.
- Start off along the scenic south side shoreline on the way to the beach.
- Have approx. 1 ½ hours to relax in the shallow clear waters. Head to Mountain Top for a picture opportunity.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Min. age is 8yrs. Min. age to drive is 25, must have a valid driver's license. 4 guests per jeep. Not recommended for pregnant women or guests with back or neck problems. Jeeps do not have a storage compartment for scooters or wheelchairs.

### Mini Boat Adventure

STTX7011

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs.

Level 3, Age, Weight

- Be the captain of your boat as you navigate to the island of Great St. James.
- Enjoy swimming at Christmas Cove.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Min. age is 9. Min. age to drive boat is 18 and you must present a valid driver's license. Pregnant women and guests with neck or back injuries or heart conditions are not permitted to participate on this excursion. Up to 4 people per mini boat. For comfort maximum combined weight must not exceed 500lbs.

### Captain Nautica Snorkel

STTX7411

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight

- Enjoy two snorkeling destinations: Turtle Cove, Ship Wreck Cove or Christmas Cove each with their own distinct snorkeling opportunities.
- Enjoy snacks while listening to local island music.

Note: Min. age is 6. Max. weight is 300lbs. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. Must be able to enter and exit the water with minimal assistance and be in good physical condition. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or guests with bad back or heart conditions

### Legendary Kon Tiki Beach & Sightseeing

STTX7511

Approx. 3 hrs.

Level 1 Famil

- Cruise through the harbour of Charlotte Amalie while sipping complimentary fruit punch and listening to music played by a calypso band.
- Pass Bluebeard's Castle, Blackbeard's Castle, the Governor's Mansion, behind Hassel and Water Island's, then the Kon Tiki will pause over a reef where she will lower her glass-bottomed viewers.
- The Kon Tiki beach stop is at Water Island, on beautiful Honeymoon Beach, where you can walk ashore to swim in the clear water or sunbathe for at least one hour. The boat will stay right at the beach for this time.
- A small boutique and snack bar are available for purchasing on board.
- Small collapsible wheelchairs are accommodated.

Note: Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Tree Limin' Extreme Zipline Tour

STTX7811

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs

Level 2, Weight, Height

- Short drive to the Zipline Park, where you will be fitted with your safety gear and receive a safety briefing.
- Then you're off to the top of the course in a Pinzgauer to experience six zip lines and two sky bridges.
- The final zip experience is called the Yo-Yo and is the only zipline of its kind in the Caribbean.

**Note:** Participants must weigh between 70 to 275lbs, and not suffer from back problems and heart conditions. Max. height is 6'6". Guests with any pre-existing injuries or expectant mothers should not participate. Close-toed shoes are required. No sandals, crocs, water socks, flats, skirts, swim suits or bare-midriffs are permitted. Sunscreen and insect repellent are highly recommended.

Twice as Nice Catamaran Sail & Snorkel

STTX8011

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs.

Level 2, Weight

- Start with a one-hour motor-sail out to Buck Island, while your crew serve you sodas, water and advise you about your snorkeling adventure.
- You'll visit two different snorkel areas Shipwreck Cove and Turtle Bay both located on Buck Island, conditions permitting.
- After receiving your snorkel gear, safety vest and instructions, your crew will lead a guided tour through this underwater haven of abundant marine life, coral formations and colorful sea-life. Keep an eye out for an inquisitive turtle, rays and maybe even a shipwreck.
- After an hour at this paradise island, you'll set sail for the return into Charlotte Amalie Harbor. Enjoy snacks, along with unlimited beers, painkillers and an open bar. Relax during your delightful sail in blue Caribbean waters, with stunning scenery and Caribbean music.

**Note:** Min age 5, max weight 260 lbs. Guests must be in good physical condition due to swimming and snorkeling in open waters. Bring a towel, cover-up or t-shirt, camera, non-oil sunscreen and cash to purchase t-shirts if desired.

### **Historic Waterfront Running Tour**

Approx. 1 1/2 hrs.

Level 3, Age

- Take in the stunning views of the harbor while soaking in the rich history of the islands in this 5K running tour through bustling Charlotte Amalie and stand on the steps of Fort Christian, a Danish-built fort that is the oldest standing structure in the USVI, climb the historic 99 steps and pass by several other historic sites and pirate hangouts.
- Enjoy a complimentary Cruzan Rum cocktail at the conclusion of your run.

Note: Participants should wear light, active clothing and sneakers. Must be in good health and medically able to walk briskly for 3.1 miles. Bring sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat. Participants are welcome to bring their own beverage if desired; bottled waters are provided.

**Historic Waterfront Power Walking Tour** 

STTX8211

Approx. 1 ½ hrs.

Level 3, Age

 Take in the stunning views of the harbor while soaking in the rich history of the islands in this 5K power-walking tour through bustling Charlotte Amalie. Stand on the steps of Fort Christian, a Danish-built fort that is the oldest standing structure in the USVI, climb the historic 99 Steps and pass by several other historic sites and pirate hangouts.

Note: Participants should wear light, active clothing and sneakers. Must be in good health and medically able to walk briskly for 3.1 miles. Bring sunscreen, sunglasses and a hat. Participants are welcome to bring their own beverage if desired; bottled waters are provided.

**Exclusive Abi Beach Getaway** 

STTX8311

Approx. 3 1/2 hrs

Level 2, Age, Weight

- Embark your boat for a cruise from Charlotte Amalie Harbor, along the coastline of St. Thomas to tranquil Abi Beach.
- Set on the 130 acre site of a former 17th century plantation; enjoy a relaxing rustic Caribbean beach experience.
- Equipment is available for snorkeling; float above undersea reef, boulders and abundant sea life along the fascinating protected reef.

Note: Min age 3, max weight 300 lbs. Snorkel equipment and swim noodles are available for a nomination fee, as well as hourly Kayak rentals. Wear swim suit, bring towel, sun protection and waterproof camera. This tour is not accessible and unsuitable for guests with walking disabilities. Guests with cardiac conditions, asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, other heart or respiratory conditions or any other medical condition should take particular caution. Food & drinks are available for purchase.

### St. John Island Tours

St. John Beach Escape & Snorkel

STTX0811

Approx. 41/2 hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight, Family

- Escape to one of the most pristine beaches of the U.S. Virgin Islands, St. John.
- Board a ferry for a short cruise through Pillsbury Sound to St. John. Hop on an open-air safari taxi to Trunk Bay.
- Photo stops include Cruz Bay overlook, Caneel Bay and Hawksnest Bay.
- Have approximately 1½ hours at Trunk Bay for swimming, snorkeling or simply relaxing, then take a short trip back to Cruz Bay.

**Note:** Ride to St. John is approx. 45 minutes each way. Bring swimsuit, towel and cash for extras. Snorkeling is optional, subject to weather conditions. Snorkel equipment and instructions are provided. Min age 8yrs, max. 80 and max. weight 300lbs. Must be able to step on and off tour boat and vehicle into and out of the water.

### St. John Eco Hike & Beach

Approx. 4½ hrs.

Level 2, Age, Weight

- Begin your hike on a hillside trail with ocean views of nearby islands.
- Your guide will provide information about the flora and fauna as well cultural and historical facts.
- Stop for a swim at Honeymoon Beach or just relax under a coconut tree. Continue on your trail to Caneel Bay's botanical gardens.
- Experience the ruins of an 18<sup>th</sup> century Danish sugar plantation and factory.

Note: Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Min. age is 8 and max. 70. Max. weight is 300lbs. Must be in good physical condition (no heart or breathing problems) and able to walk over uneven terrain in a tropical climate. The ride to St. John is approximately 45 minutes each way.

### St. John Island Tour

STTX2111

STTX5611

Approx. 4½ hrs.

Level 1. Age, Fami

- View some of the most wonderful sights in the Caribbean, stop at overlooks such as Cinnamon Bay, Trunk Bay and Caneel Bay.
- Shopping opportunity at Cruz Bay at the end of the tour before returning to the ship

Note: The ferry ride to St. John is approximately 45 minutes each way.

St. John Champagne Catamaran Sail & Snorkel

Approx. 4 ½ hrs

Level 2, Age, Weight, Family

- Sail across Pillsbury Sound to your St. John mooring destination and swim off a beautiful St. John beach, snorkel or simply relax.
- Enjoy breads, cheeses, fruits and a variety of beverages onboard.
- Champagne, rum drinks and beer are complimentary after swimming and snorkeling.

Note: Min. age is 6yrs. Max. weight 350lbs. Wear swimsuit and bring a towel. Alternate snorkel site may be used based on weather and sea conditions. There are several steps required to enter and exit the water. Guests entering the water must be able to re-board the vessel without assistance. Must be 21 years of age to consume alcohol and present valid ID. The ride to St. John is approximately 45 minutes each way

# Tortola, British Virgin Islands

## Shore Excursion Level Definitions & Other Information

Level 1: Tours with this designation involve walking over relatively level terrain. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

Level 2: Tours with this designation can involve a considerable amount of physical activity such as walking over cobblestones or uneven surfaces, climbing many stairs or steep terrain, bicycle riding, swimming and snorkeling. They are not recommended for guests with walking difficulties.

This is a two-tank dive at the most famous wreck dive in the Caribbean, the 'RMS Rhone', which went down in 1867 during a hurricane.

• The first dive is an exploration of the bow, which lies mostly intact in 80 feet of water.

• The second dive is then a tour of the stern section, which lies between 35 to 60 feet and is much more broken up.

During both dives your guide will point out many of the historical points of interest that still remain on the wreck.

The Rhone is also home to an abundance of marine life and corals. Divers regularly encounter turtles, green moray eels and reef sharks.

Note: Participants must be at least 15 years of age and comfortable walking approximately one mile. Proof of certification is required. Alternate sites may be chosen due to weather and sea conditions. All equipment is provided.
